The below is the current guideline ... Item 7: Matches –

- ❖ When the temperature is 40° or lower or 95° or higher at the host club including windchill based on information from The Weather Channel - [National and Local Weather Radar, Daily Forecast, Hurricane and information from The Weather Channel and weather.com](#) - at the pre-scheduled match start time, the start time can be changed upon agreement by both captains; however, every effort should be made to play the match on the originally scheduled date. The LA is to be advised of such situation.

The Guideline now includes a windchill calculator at the end of the special note.
